Friday 18th November ~ Children in Need Day (non-uniform) ~ £1 donation

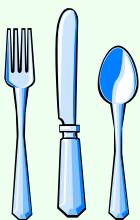
Thursday 15th December ~ Christmas Jumper Day for Save the Children ~ £1 donation

The cost of a school meal in Years 3 to 6 is £2.30 (a week is £11.50.)

School meals MUST be paid for in advance. Payment is required online where a minimum of five meals must be purchased at any one time. The cost of the first half of the Autumn term is £80.50.
