If you have a child born between **1st September 2018** and **31st August 2019** you must apply for a place by midnight on Sunday **15th January 2023**.

Choosing the right primary school for your child is one of the most important decisions you will have to make. ## Splitting the £1.00

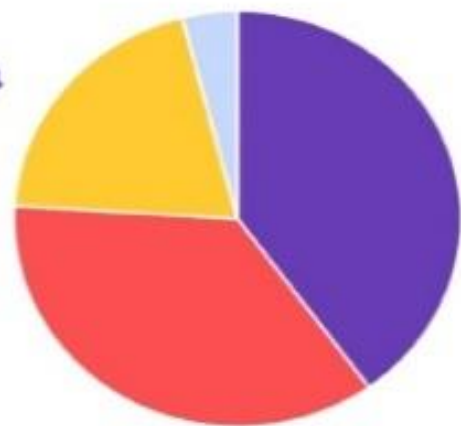
### How it works...
